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The Baltimore Metropolitan Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. is pleased to distribute our 2019 Scholarship Application. Our chapter will be awarding a four-year renewable scholarship in the amount of \$1500.00 and a four-year renewable scholarship in the amount of \$2000.00 to deserving high school seniors. The selected scholars must maintain a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA to remain eligible for the scholarships.

**Note: Interviews will take place on MARCH 16, 2019 for all applicants who are selected as potential scholarship recipients.**

Scholarship Applications are evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Eligible applicants must attend a Baltimore City or Baltimore County Public or Private School
- Completed Legible Application (Type or print in black ink.)
- Quality of Essay (A discussion of academic achievement, education, career goals, personal experiences, and extracurricular activities.) **no more than one page in length**
- Official High School Transcript **signed by a high school official**
- Acceptance Letter from College or University, if received
- Two Letters of Recommendation from Two High School Officials (letters must be on official letterhead)
- Proof of Service Learning Activities
- Official SAT/ACT scores - Minimum SAT Score of 850 (Math and Writing\Reading), or an ACT Score of at least 19
- A wallet-sized headshot photo attached to the completed application

Delta Sigma Theta Sorority was founded on January 13, 1913 by twenty-two collegiate women at Howard University and incorporated in 1930. These students wanted to use their collective strength to promote academic excellence and to provide assistance to persons in need. The first public act performed by our beloved Founders took place barely two months after the founding of our sorority, when they participated in the Women's Suffrage March held in Washington D.C. in March 1913.

A sisterhood of more than 200,000 predominately Black college educated women, the Sorority currently has over 900 chapters located in the United States, England, Japan (Tokyo and Okinawa), Germany, the Virgin Islands, Bermuda, the Bahamas and the Republic of Korea. The major programs of the sorority are based upon the sorority's Five Point Programmatic Thrust:

- Economic Development
- Educational Development
- International Awareness and Involvement
- Physical and Mental Health
- Political Awareness and Involvement
